Viola Blackberry Cream is a freeflowering, lightly scented viola which produces a mass of flowers reminiscent of a dainty dish of delicious blackberries and cream.

Violas have a uniform, mounded and compact habit making them ideal for bedding displays. They are one of the most popular cooler season annuals flowering over many months. For best results plant in a sunny position in fertile, well-drained soil, and apply a liquid fertiliser regularly.

Position: Full sun, part shade.

Height: 20-25cm approx.

Plant: 10cm apart.

Flowering: 6-8 weeks after planting.

Tips: Larger blooms, deeper colours and more prominent petal markings occur during the cooler months. Deadhead to promote fresh blooms.
